1. OHA Transformation Center and Public Health Division Offer Free Online Tobacco Counseling Training

What: Tobacco cessation counseling online training for all types of providers and care team members. This training is a self-paced, online training that focuses on the Brief Tobacco Intervention and Motivational Interviewing techniques. When: Launches July 16, 2018. The training takes approximately 45 minutes. This self-paced course can be started, paused and resumed later as needed.

2. Webinar – Mindfulness: Cultivating a Practice to Support Your Work. July 19, 11:00 a.m.-noon.

Description: This webinar will offer Community Advisory Council (CAC) members insights into how mindfulness can provide support to those who have experienced trauma and how cultivating a mindfulness practice of our own can lead to greater compassion, safer spaces, and more effective communication with those we serve. We'll cover an introduction to mindfulness, the benefits of relational presence, and the various ways to begin or return to a meaningful, restorative mindfulness practice that supports you in navigating the stressors in day-to-day life.

3. Developmental screening and follow-up tip sheets, guides and webinars. The Transformation Center is partnering with the Oregon Pediatric Improvement Partnership (OPIP) to develop tip sheets, guides and webinar-based Q&A sessions for CCOs. Secondly, OPIP will develop overview guides and a webinar for primary care providers on developmental screening and follow-up (referrals and connection to supportive services for children when indicated by developmental screening results). This technical assistance does not include regional assistance on refining and tailoring the tools or implementation support to practices and communities. It is meant to provide a high-level summary of what is needed to consider and support these efforts. This technical assistance is meant to be complementary to the focused implementation projects that several regions of Oregon are engaged in with OPIP. It will not replace the work already happening or planned.
