Need to Know

The OHA Medicaid Unit's team is currently undergoing some changes. Jennifer Smith is now on leave through June, and [Michelle Meuwissen](#) is transitioning to a new role within OHA within the next few months. Michelle continues to be our primary contact for APCM/FQHCs until Jennifer returns.

Due to the constrained resources available for APCM work, the following activities are being delayed. These decisions were made earlier this week by the APCM Steering Committee.

1. The re-start of the Non-Engaged Closure Reports (NECRs) and overall Non-Engaged Patient Closure process is now scheduled for Q3 2022. An updated one-pager will be distributed soon, and a new addendum will be drawn up to replace the one signed earlier this year.
2. The revised Participation Agreement and list of carved-out codes will be finalized and distributed in late summer or early fall.
3. Q1 quarterly reports should be sent in July along with Q2 quarterly reports.
